This year, CMA has really taken off in Switzerland! A total of 14 competitions in the two disciplines of pistol and 2-gun are on the program. The highlight of the competition year is undoubtedly the upcoming Swiss Pistol Championship.

After a successful debut in 2024, we are very grateful to be able to hold the match again at the state-of-the-art Widstud shooting range in Bülach. We have four shooting rooms available at the same time, one of which is 50 meters long.

Our sponsors deserve a very special thank you. I hope you will give them special consideration. This will result in a lasting partnership and make large, attractive shooting events possible on a permanent basis.

As you surely know, all competitions are based on the extensive and intensive volunteer work of the match directors, safety officers, and helpers. Please don't forget to thank your SOs from time to time. Without them, there would be no competitions.

We will prepare eight challenging and entertaining stages for you. In addition, there will be an equipment check, an exhibition, and a raffle. After the announcement of the rankings, there will be a dinner for those who have registered for it at the range.

Schedule

For reasons of efficiency, there will be no pre-match. The SOs will therefore rotate with their squads and shoot the stages together.

We will shoot stages in four rooms simultaneously. In an additional room we will carry out the equipment check in the morning and an exhibition in the afternoon. There will be a short break for reorganization at half-time during the competition.

Friday, October 17	
Stage building and preparation according to separate plan. Approximately from 18:00 for staff and helpers.	
Saturday, October 18	
07:00	Staff briefing and preparation
From 08:00	Arrival of shooters
08:30	Shooters briefing on ground level
09:00	Match Start Stages 1-4 and equipment check
Followed by	Short lunch break and rebuild
13:00	Stages 5-8 and exhibition
17:00	Cleanup
18:00	Awards followed by dinner

After cleanup, the awards ceremony will take place in the large hall on the ground floor. For those participants who have registered, there will then be a mutual dinner to bring the day to a pleasant close.

Stages

The stages will be published one week before the match.

You can expect a variety of challenges, such as moving targets, different shooting positions, rapid and relatively long movements, distances of 5-40m, low light, and so on. Some special physical exercises may also be required.

Match Administration

Registration

Registration is exclusively via Practiscore. Participants can enter registration details such as division and class directly there and update them later as necessary. The match will be downloaded to the scoring tablets on October 17, after which no further changes will be possible.

All participants must also register with Widstud in order to gain access to the shooting ranges. Anyone who does not yet have a Widstud badge should, if possible, obtain one directly from Widstud in advance.

Squadding

Shooters can choose their squad themselves on Practiscore. The competition management will fill up the squads shortly before the competition day and, if necessary, balance them to ensure that the competition runs smoothly. The final allocation will be announced at the shooters briefing.

Catering

When registering, you can select the option that includes meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner). Your physical well-being will be taken care of accordingly, with:

Breakfast: Coffee and croissants

Lunch: Sandwich and drink

Dinner: Menu and drink

The short break at halftime during the match will be used for lunch. For efficiency reasons, this will be kept as short as possible.

Safety

The safety of all persons on the range is the top priority during the competition. Sports shooting is fun, but the firearms we use are not toys. Make sure that your handling skills are impeccable and that you know and apply the safety rules at all times.

Depending on the stage design, CMA can be a very fast sport. However, the shooter must stay on top of what's happening at all times. Sometimes it's better to go a little slower in order to avoid unnecessary risks.

Universal Safety Rules

The universal safety rules for firearms have to be adhered to at all times. Violations will result in a disqualification! No exceptions will be tolerated.



Cold Range

The match will be held under the cold range rules. Some important points to remember:

- Transfer of the firearm from the bag to the holster and back can only be done in a safe area or under the command of a safety officer
- The firearm carried in the holster has to be unloaded, external hammer (if present) de-cocked and no magazine inserted
- Manipulation of the firearm can be done only on command of an SO or in the safe area
- Manipulation of ammunition can be done anywhere on the range, except in a safe area

Finger

Please be careful to observe proper finger discipline at all times: keep your finger clearly outside and above the trigger guard until you are ready to shoot. The SOs are instructed to strictly enforce finger safety for all shooters.

Muzzle

The 180-rule applies on all stages. Additionally, exclusion zones (e.g. on doors) may be defined and will be pointed out in the stage briefing.

Safety Fault Lines

Safety fault lines (minimum distance) may be defined for certain targets in open stages. Overstepping these line while shooting will result in a disqualification.

Hitting Barricades

Hitting barricades that are part of a shooting position will result in a disqualification.

Other Important

Shooters License

All participants must have a valid CMA shooting license for pistols. The status can be viewed on the CMA website on the personal dashboard. The shooting license consists of a valid CMA membership and a valid skills test.

Equipment Check

All equipment used must comply with CMA rules. One of the stages in the morning will be an equipment check. Both the weapons and the rest of the equipment will be checked in accordance with the rules. If any deficiencies are found, the shooter may be subject to penalties up to and including disqualification.

Exhibition and Price Draw

One of the stages in the afternoon will be an exhibition and participation in a raffle with attractive prizes for all participants.

Patching and Stage Reset

Every shooter is expected to help patch the targets and reset the stages. Please make sure that you only patch after the SOs have finished scoring that particular target.

Eating and Drinking

We ask all shooters to make use of the offer on the range. You should not eat in the shooting ranges.

Accommodation and Transportation

The shooters have to make arrangements for accommodation and transport themselves. The match management is available in case of questions.

Withdrawal and Refund

As described in the waiver on Practiscore, a refund will only be granted in cases of force majeure, such as illness or accident. In any case, a refund remains the decision of the competition management.
